- Be punctual
- Expect some introductions and pleasantries
- Introduce yourself and share where you are from
- If you are in a group, make sure to introduce everyone
- Explain you are here to discuss aging issues
- A Personal Story provides an EMOTIONAL IMPACT
- Allow time to ask them if they have any questions for you
- And it's ok if they ask you something you don't have an answer for; tell them you will get back to them
- Always follow up by sending a thank you card or email and invitation to your community
